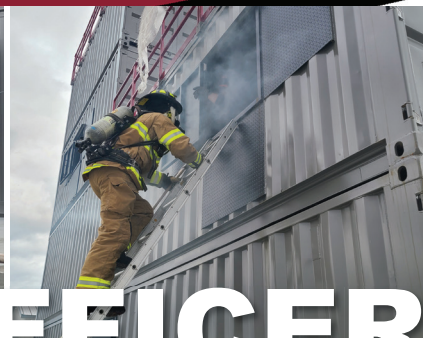


ADULT EDUCATION



FIRE OFFICER I & II



This course is designed to teach students to develop critical thinking skills, build staff communication, foster team building, understand leadership/management theories, and create a professional environment. Students must complete pre-coursework, participate in group discussions, deliver oral presentations, and complete in-class written work assignments as part of the curriculum. The Fire Officer I course will follow the NFPA 1021 standards for Fire Officer Professional Qualifications.

- Completion of NIMS 100, 200 & 700
- High School diploma or equivalent
- Current and valid ODPS Firefighter I or Firefighter II
