Coursework emphasizes real-world application and covers key topics such as defensive driving, traffic accident investigation, firearms training, subject control, physical and tactical skills, de-escalation techniques, and police procedures and law. Graduates are well prepared to pursue a variety of careers in public safety and law enforcement.

## Job Outlook:

(SOC Code 33-3051) Employment of police and detectives is projected to **grow 3% from 2022 to 2032**, faster than the average for all occupations. The continued desire for public safety is expected to lead to new openings for officers, although demand may vary by location. The median annual wage in Ohio is **\$74,910**.
