

Frequently Asked Questions

What is the Application Process?

Prospective students with parent/guardian complete secured, online application. Upon successful submission of the application, prospective students receive an email confirmation with pertinent additional information and resources.

Applications received are considered intent to attend MCCC are dated and time-stamped in compliance with the Ohio Department of Education procedures and policies.

What is the Selection Criteria Review?

May include, but is not limited to student grades, coursework foundation for CTE program rigor, aptitude, and attendance based on industry standards and approved Course of Study.

Why do applicants have a 1st and 2nd Choice Program Option?

Students from six Medina County school districts and adjacent counties apply to MCCC. In order to maximize student learning and maintain personalized instruction, our CTE programs have limited class sizes. Students may be selected for their second choice program if the first choice program is oversubscribed and/or based on the selection criteria requirements.
