Daily Professional Dress Policy:

Members of our Advisory Committee have recommended that uniforms be worn while in lab. This is done for the safety and protection of each student and is a requirement in Criminal Justice.

- Please remember to have the attached <u>Health and Wellness Physical Form</u> completed by your physician when class begins so as to not hold up the ability to begin physical skills training.
- Because of the nature of some of the equipment, training, and departmental guidelines, facial hair, piercings, tattoos and extreme styles are not allowed in uniform. Students who do not comply with these standards, may not successfully complete the Criminal Justice Program.
- For the safety and protection of each student in the Criminal Justice Program, students are required to purchase Black Patrol Boots (black, polish-able, all leather or synthetic. No jungle boots & no shoes.) Patrol boots are required. Patrol boots can be purchased when you order your uniforms from Akron Uniforms. You may buy from other retailers but you risk buying boots that do not meet our standards. Boots are not part of student fees and must be purchased by student.

*The Patrol Uniform is part of the Student Fees and no payment is needed at the time of ordering from the vendor below.
