FIRST YEAR PROGRAM INFORMATION

DRESS CODE (Uniform listed below is student purchased and not part of student fees)



- ◆ **Navy blue** scrub top (no button down or snap)
- ◆ **Navy blue** scrub pants
- ◆ **Navy blue** or **white** warm-up jacket or lab coat
- ◆ All white shoes with white laces (no cloth, no mesh, and **no clogs with open backs or holes**)
- ◆ Socks (no footies . . . Must cover ankles)
- ◆ Optional **navy blue**, solid white, black or gray t-shirt (short or long sleeved) to be worn under scrub top.



Adherence to the DMT dress code is expected throughout the school day.
Instructors will determine if appearance complies with dress code.

DURING LAB . . .

- ✓ Conservative necklaces at the instructor's discretion
- ✓ Body piercing jewelry may not be visible except in the ear lobes. No more than two pair of simple, non-hoop earrings.
- ✓ Professionally kept **natural-colored hair** secured off shoulders and away from face
- ✓ Name badge must be worn
- ✓ Supplies required for daily lab including a black or blue pen
- ✓ Nails should be clean and short; nail polish if worn, shall be freshly applied and not chipped
