#### Law Enforcement Job Outlook According to the Bureau of Labor Statistics (CIP Code-43.0107)

(SOC Code 33-3051) Employment of police and detectives is projected to grow 7 % from 2020 to 2030, faster than the average for all occupations. The continued desire for public safety is expected to lead to new openings for officers, although demand may vary by location. The median annual wage for police and detectives was \$65,340 in January 2022. In Ohio, jobs in the police and sheriff's patrol officers' fields are expected to grow by 1% by the year 2028.
