- Only students receiving their Career Passport will be invited to attend the Senior Awards ceremony.
- All fees (MCCC & homeschool) must be paid and all school resources (chromebooks/textbooks, etc.) must be returned by April 27, 2026 for your student to participate in the Senior Awards ceremony.
- Eight (8) guest tickets, plus one ticket for your student, will be available for students to pick up beginning April 27, 2026. Additional tickets will not be available. Students needing extra seating will need to ask classmates for their tickets. No student or guest will be admitted without a ticket.
- Students will be receiving MCCC chords that may be worn at our ceremony and their home school graduation.
- Students are to arrive at 6:15 pm. Guests will be admitted at 6:30 pm. **See attached map for parking and entrance instructions.**
- **Student's Attire - Job interview attire is required.** NO shorts, jeans, short dresses or short skirts, halter or crop tops, low cut tops, or spaghetti straps, t-shirts, hats, flip flops, old tennis shoes, or dirty boots. Administration has the right to decline student participation based on non-professional attire.
