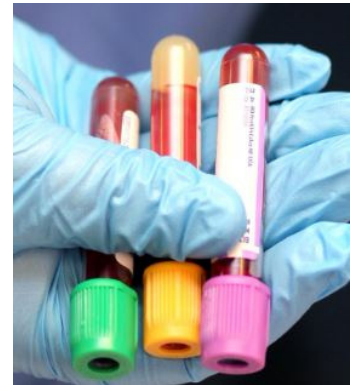

Phlebotomy Technician Job Outlook According to the Bureau of Labor Statistics

(SOC Code 31-9097) Employment of nursing aides, orderlies, and attendants is expected to grow by 22% from 2020 to 2030, much faster than the average for all occupations. Hospitals, diagnostic laboratories, blood donor centers, and other locations will need phlebotomists to perform bloodwork. The median annual wage in Ohio is \$34,630.
