Certified Nurse Aide (CNA) Job Outlook According to the Bureau of Labor Statistics (SOC Code-31.1012)

Employment of certified nurse aides (CNA) is projected to grow 4% from 2023 to 2033, about as fast as the average for all occupations. About 209,400 openings for nursing aides and orderlies are projected each year, on average, over the decade. Many of those openings are expected to result from the need to replace workers who transfer to different occupations or exit the labor force, such as to retire.
